PROGRAM DETAILS

January 29th - Day 1: Welcome to Egypt

Upon arrival, you'll be welcomed at the airport by one of our representatives who will assist you during customs and visa process. Transfer from Cairo international airport to your hotel in Cairo (Fairmont Nile city Cairo or Sofitel el Gezira)

Overnight in Cairo.



January 30th - Day 2: Giza Pyramids and the Sphinx (L,D)

9 am – After breakfast, start your first-day Cairo tour of the **pyramids** with our guide from your hotel in Cairo visiting Giza Pyramids and the Sphinx, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. start your tour by the Great Pyramid of Cheops (2551-2528 BC). Then move to Chephren Pyramid and then to the Panorama area, enjoy an awesome photo of the nine Pyramids, then move to the Sphinx, visit the Valley Temple and the Sphinx.

This tour will last approx. 2-3 hours tour and there will be the option to visit the Great pyramid inside (tickets approx. **\$15-20 sold on site**)

Lunch will be organized at a local restaurant.

In the evening, dinner on a cruise on the Nile with belly-dancing show. Overnight in Cairo

January 31st - Day 3: tour to Coptic Cairo, Saladin citadel, and Khan El Khalili Bazar (L)

Today you are going to visit the Coptic area with the hanging church and Abu serge church then to Salah El den Citadel to visit the Alabaster Mosque of Mohammed Ali. Then headed to the Bazar (Khan El Khalili).

Food tour visiting authentic Egyptian restaurants to sample delicious cuisine and to get an insight into local life.



Free time in the evening. Overnight in Cairo.

February 1st - Day 4: Private transfer to Cairo Airport and flight to Aswan. (D)

Upon arrival at Aswan Airport you will be met by our local representative and transferred by private vehicle to your hotel. (approx. 20 min)

After breakfast, we will transfer to the Temple of Philae: visit the great Philae island temple. A boat trip to the Temple of Philae, which was built in honor of the goddess Isis. Lunch at a Nubian restaurant.

A Felucca ride around Kitchener Island in Aswan, Egypt is a unique and relaxing way to experience the Nile River and the surrounding landscape. A Felucca is a traditional Egyptian sailboat, typically powered by the wind and is an ideal way to explore the Nile River.

Dinner at one of the famous restaurants in Aswan

February 3rd - Day 6: Free Day enjoying the Movenpick resort (D)

The morning is yours to enjoy!

At night a free walking in Aswan market which is famous for the spices

Dinner at the hotel and overnight in Aswan

February 4th - Day 7: transfer to Luxor stopping by Edfu temple (L,D)

After breakfast, check out from Aswan and transfer to Luxor with Edfu temple stop along the way (pic-nic lunch provided)

Around 3pm - Check in your 5* hotel in Luxor. 4:30pm - Visit of Luxor temple by sunset.

Dinner will be organized at a rooftop restaurant with a view.



February 5th - Day 8: tour to the valley of the kings and Hatshepsut temple (L,D)

In the morning, visit to the Valley of the Kings Lunch by local restaurant in front of Habu temple.

The sound and light show at Karnak Temple 1 hour , and Barbeque Dinner on the Nile

February 6th - Day 9: Luxor (cooking class)

The day is yours to enjoy and relax. A cooking lesson at the west bank of Luxor will be organized (TBC).



February 7th - Day 10: transfer by modern bus to Hurghada. 4 hours desert road! (D)

Check in your hotel (Marriott or Hilton) on **half Bord basis**

Dinner at the hotel

February 8th - Day 11: R&R by the Red Sea

Optional: boat trip to the orange bay including 2 snorkeling stops and lunch at the orange bay Island. Free time to relax.

February 9th - Day 12: Day 4 Cairo Museum. (D)

Flights from Hurgada to Cairo, check in at hotel and, in the afternoon, visit to Cairo Museum.

See the masterpieces of the museum on the ground floor and the collection of tut Ankh Amon on the second floor.

February 10th - Day 13: departure from Egypt

After breakfast, private transfer to Airport in Cairo and fly back home.
